

LTHS JV & Freshmen Uniform Turn in Procedures:

1. All uniforms must be "laundered" at a dry-cleaning facility. Dry cleaning **is not** good for the uniforms; therefore, they **must** be laundered. If any uniform is ruined due to dry cleaning, you will have to pay to replace it.
2. The uniforms and midriff top must be returned in the plastic bag from the cleaners. A dated receipt must be attached to the bag or it will be given back.
3. If there are any holes in your uniforms, they **must** be sewn prior to you turning them in. If the slit in the cheer skirt has torn farther up the leg than it was originally set, it must be sewn back to its normal length. If there are any stains, you must try to get them out or we will send back to you.

List of laundered dry clean items to turn in for JV and Freshmen:

- LT shell top
- LTHS shell top
- Blazers shell top
- Green cheer skirt (simple with braid at bottom)
- Green cheer skirt (intricate braid and inverted V at bottom)
- Green midriff top with long sleeves

Please wash the below items and hang them to dry before turning in:

- Green warm up jacket
- Green warm up pants
- LT Cheer Head warmer
- Green Gloves

Miscellaneous:

- 1 Forest Green and 1 Gold Pom and/or Competition Poms

Turning in your uniform in an unsatisfactory condition or not turning in your uniform will be reported as destruction of school property or stolen school property. You will be placed on the fines list and not receive report cards, schedules, etc. Please let us know if you have any questions.
